Harvest Preparatory School is a preschool through 12th grade private Christian school. The school is located on a 58-acre campus on the Southeast side of Columbus, in Canal Winchester, Ohio. The school is divided into three divisions: Lower School (Preschool-Grade 5), Middle School (Grades 6-8), and Upper School (Grades 9-12). The school is a chartered non-public private school and meets or exceeds all expectations established by the Ohio Department of Education. Since 1986, the school has maintained membership status with the Association of Christian Schools International. The school is presently working towards full accreditation through the Association of Christian Schools International and Cognia.

ACADEMICS

Our school offers a variety of courses to meet the academic needs and educational interests of our students. We encourage students to enroll in rigorous courses to include Advanced Placement and Honors. Students meeting entrance standards for College Credit Plus have the opportunity to take courses through our partner schools – Ohio Christian University and Columbus State Community College. Students in the Upper School operate on a college preparatory block schedule, comprised of four 80-minute classes each day. Graduating seniors have the opportunity to qualify for the State of Ohio Academic Honors Diploma.

ACTIVITIES

Harvest Preparatory School is a member of the Ohio High School Athletic Association (OHSAA). Harvest Prep's athletic program includes basketball, baseball, cheerleading, football, soccer, softball, track & field, and volleyball. Additional opportunities for involvement include community service, missions, visual art, instrumental and vocal music, academic quiz bowl, National Honor Society, National Art Honor Society, Student Senate, and the Warrior Leadership Academy.

All candidates for May graduation are ranked based on their GPA computed in August, at the beginning of their senior year, and again in January. The Valedictorian and Salutatorian honors are selected at the end of the 3rd quarter (March) based on transcripted grades. The final GPA is calculated in June.
